

\$5 Quilt Club Rules - 2012

Thank you for joining our **Ninth Annual \$5 Quilt Club for 2012**. Our 2011 \$5 Quilt Club was a big success and we want to thank all of you who participated. For 2012 we are making a sampler quilt with add on blocks. Embroidery will be an option for the center of the \$5 block. If you choose to do the embroidery designs we will be offering the CD with designs and threads needed. **These will need to be purchased at the beginning of the year as the embroidery is the center of the block.** Our main fabric is Sweet Emily and Elizabethtown by Andover Fabrics, with Moda's Bella for the background. We will have 125 kits. "Finishing kits" will include borders and the binding. Backing will not be included although we will have a 20% off day for backs later in the year. This \$5 quilt will make a large bed size quilt (approx 90" x 90"). Backing and finishing kits will need to be purchased separately. You will need to sign up early for finishing kits. Sign up dates will be announced. **Please know that when you sign up you are agreeing to continue through to the end of the year.** We ask that you honor your commitment and purchase all blocks that you miss. Each person who signs up will have all 12 blocks and add-ons reserved just for them.

1. **\$5 Quilt Club Day will be the third Saturday of each month. (Unless otherwise announced.)**
2. **MEETING TIMES HAVE NOT CHANGED!!!!** In order to accommodate more members, there will be **two** opportunities on Club Day for you to get your blocks, **9:00am and 1:00pm**. Club meetings will last no more than 30 minutes which will include block information, tips, new product previews, and "show and tell."
3. You must be **in the door NO LATER** than 9:05am or 1:05pm in order to get your block free. There will be **no exceptions!!!!** These will be the only times that you **CAN** get your block free! **Please do not ask us to show special treatment. It will not be fair to the others.**
4. We will be giving each of you a 5 dollar bill as you enter, to get your block free. If you miss the 9:05 deadline you must wait until the 1:00 time in order to get your block free.
5. You must show your block from the previous month, **completed**, in order to get your block free! No exceptions!! Please do not bring an unfinished block and ask for a free block.
6. You may send someone to pick up your block at the designated free time, paying the \$5. You must pick up your block yourself in order to get it free.
7. If you miss the "Club Day" deadline, you may pick up your block at any time during the month, after "Club Day," paying the \$5. You do not have to show your finished block and anyone may pick it up for you.
8. Please start working on your block early enough to take care of any problems you may have, or that we may have created by mistakes. We promise to work hard to try to avoid mistakes, but they still might happen. We will be glad to help you with your block at any time, except at the "Club Day" meeting times. Please feel free to ask questions any other time.
9. The "add on" blocks this year will be \$7.00 each month.
10. You may do as many \$5 Quilts as you wish or as supplies last. There will be only one free block per person per month. You will have to pay the \$5 per additional block.
11. Blocks will be available on or after "Club Day."
12. We will not be able to go back and kit previous blocks. If for any reason you need another block, we will try to help you get the fabrics. Substitutions may be necessary. There is no guarantee that there will be any fabrics left after the kits are made.
