

Tool Roll Up!

Fabric Requirements:

- 1 - 12 1/2" pieced block
- 1 - 14" square batting
- 1 - 14" square backing
- 1 - 12 1/2" square dark fabric for inside pocket
- 1 - 1" x 25" strip of fabric for tie
- 56" of 2 1/4" binding



To make the roll up, layer your block, batting and backing fabric just as you would a quilt. Fold the dark fabric in half with right sides together.

Lay the folded fabric to the bottom of the layered block on top of the backing fabric.

Pin layers and quilt through all the layer to create pockets.

Sew the strip of fabric to make the tie by folding and pressing in half with right sides together. Then fold the raw edges into the fold and press. This will look like bias tape. Stitch along the two folded edges. Fold in half and stitch down on the block side while sewing the binding on. Check the length of the tie by wrapping around the roll up after adding the tools. Trim and tie each end.

Sew on binding just as you would for a quilt.



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
