

Quick & Easy Pillowcase

Fabric Requirements for standard pillow case:

3/4 yard for Body (27")
1/3 yard for Border
2" strip for Accent

Fabric requirements for King size pillow case:

1 yard for Body (36")
1/3 yard for Border
2" strip for Accent

Pillow case can be made in 15 minutes.
All width of fabric is around 42" to 44".

1. Place 12" Border piece right side face up on table. (A)
2. Lay 27" Body piece face up on top of Border piece and line up edges at top. (B)
3. Press 2" accent piece in half lengthways right sides out and lay on top of Body piece (C) and line up all raw edges at top and pin all three pieces together. (D)
4. Roll the Body piece up from the bottom until it is centered on top of the Border piece. (D)
5. Bring the bottom of the Border piece up to the pinned edge and pin it to the other raw edges. (E)
6. Congratulations....you now have a tube. (F)
7. Sew 1/4" seam allowance.
8. Pull the Body piece out of the tube. This will be slightly difficult but work the Border fabric down as you pull the Body fabric out of the center.
9. You now have a flat pillow case. (G) Iron the Border, then fold right sides together and sew your last two seams (side and bottom) to complete the case. Use a serger or zig-zag stitch to finish seams.

Have fun mixing and matching three different fabrics to make dynamic pillow cases for family and friends. Good for weddings, birthdays, and holidays. Kids love them...the wilder the better. Just remember to choose fabric that will be soft and smooth to lay your face on.
